

WARNING:


- 1. This swing must be assembled by two adults or more.
- 2. Tools are not included in packaging. The expected time required for assembly is usually 1-2hours.
- 3. Before assembly, ensure all parts are present and not damaged.
- 4. Assembly on a flat, hard, and debris-free surface.
- 5. Keep canopy swing away from fire or inflammable objects.
- 6. There are small parts are present in the packaging, do keeping small parts away from children.
- 7. Children should be accompanied under the adults when use the swing.
- 8. Do not repack your swing until it is completely dry.
- 9. This swing must not be left erect in high wind conditions.
- 10. Do not place your swing in wet conditions where there is a risk of rust developing.
- 11. When not in use, wipe free of any dirt or loose objects, Do not use strong detergent or abrasive cleaners.
- 12. When not in use, store in a cool, dry location away from sunlight.





Step 3: Expand the cover N, have one end of I and J1(J2) pass through N and then plug in H as Fig. 3 show. Step 4: Connect another side of H and J to connector K separaltey as Fig. 4 show.




Step 5: Plug E into U shpe tube F, make sure the snap buckle is locked in place as Fig 5 show.

Step 5-1: Insert another side of E into D/D1 as Fig 5-1 show.

Step 6: Connect the upper of M to D/D 1on G with AA/FF/HH as Fig. 6 show.

(Note – DO NOT fix another side of G in this step)


Step 7: Unscrew the nut on U, have U through D/D1 and then screwed as Fig. 7 show.




- Step 8: Plug the pre-assembled K into the tube connector on C as Fig. 8 show.
- Step 9: Insert the end of three connector J1(J2) into the tube of L, and attach L to C with CC, GG and II as
- Fig.9-1 show. Attach the hook on N to the connector of L as Fig. 9-2 show.
- Step 11: Connect the upper of M to E/ D/D 1 on G with BB/FF/HH as Fig. 11 show.

Step 10: Unscrew the nut on U downward as Fig. 10-1 show. Attach the U to C as Fig. 10-2 show.

Step. 12: Connect the bottom part of M to A1 with AA/FF/HH as Fig. 12 show.



Step 13: Have rope R cross through the holes on Q, hang Q on the U shape F on the connector E of D/D1 as Fig. 13 show. (Note: the end of the Rope should be at the place where it start on the lower part of T) Step 14: Have the connector tube T throgh Q as Fig. 14-1 show, lock T on D/D1 with CC/DD as Fig. 14-2 show.
